### Art de la Guerre tournament

This year the theme of the tournament will be Europe and the feudal Mediterranean from 1050 to 1329. The authorized lists are given in the annex. There will be no elephants or heavy knights.

- **Scale:** 15 mm, all figures must be painted, based and representative.
- List choice: Only two identical army lists are allowed. The referee will tell you if your list is already taken.
- **Army list:** Each player must provide his army composition in 200 points maximum by Sunday 19 June. Please use the standard Excel form available on the website.
- **Games duration:** 2 hours 30 minutes with a minimum of 7 turns. The game ends on the defender's turn.
- **Terrain:** Players must bring correct and representative terrain elements. Cardboard pieces and oddly shaped or inappropriate elements are not allowed.
- Playing area: Tables will be 120 x 80 cm.
- **Rules:** V4 rules with the latest clarifications.
- **Camps looting:** A special bonus of 10 points will be given to the player who looted the most camps during the tournament. Tied players will get a bonus of 5 pts each.
- **Pairings:** Pairings in the first round will be random (avoiding matches between teams of the same club). Thereafter the Swiss system will be used.
- Available places: 32 players.
- **Partial participation:** It is possible to come and play only on Saturday. Please indicate this at the time of registration.



## Venue access

The venue is a 12 minutes' walk from Part-Dieu station (metro line B Part-Dieu). The Sans-Soucis metro line D station is also a 10-minute walk away (south on the map). The venue is on the T3 tram line from Part Dieu (Dauphiné Lacassagne station).

#### By Walk

Leave the Part-Dieu station on the Place of Francfort side. Take rue Flandin to the intersection with rue Paul Bert. Then take Avenue Lacassagne to number 36.
